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THE BEER

The Crazy Donkey label signifies the first IPA (India Pale Ale) produced in Greece. Received with enthusiasm by beer aficionados near and far, the Crazy Donkey has traveled to Australia, the US, Norway, Denmark, Switzerland and the UK. Large quantities of 'Cascade' and 'Nelson Sauvin' hops yield a plethora of aromatic bitterness - marrying an arguably tropical start to a dry finish, for a distinctly different drinking adventure. Produced in very limited quantities.

THE STORY

A Serbian brewer, a multi-talented American, a Greek oenologist and an English wine aficionado and owner of the Rocky Head Brewery in London came together in 2011 to create the newest microbrewery in Santorini, with the aim of revitalizing the - until then - boring Greek beer scene.

BREWING

The brewing operations take place with the latest equipment imported from Austria. Malted barley is milled and then submitted to a technique known as "mashing", which yields the liquid wort that is then boiled with aromatic hops gathered from all around the world. Primary fermentation begins with the addition of specialized yeasts, and secondary fermentation takes place under pressure in large storage tanks without any extra sugar - only that which is produced naturally during the brewing process. These seemingly facile steps result in a fresh beer experience never before available in Santorini. Unfiltered, unpasteurized and preservative-free, every particle of flavor is captured in these "living" ales. Best enjoyed refrigerated.
