VINEYARDS

Biologically certified vineyards in the Petri, Koutsi and Karfoxilia areas of Nemea in the Peloponnese region of Greece. Altitudes of 400-600m.

SOIL

Light limestone soil with good drainage and high copper content.

HARVEST

Second half of October, hand harvested.

VINIFICATION

The grapes are hand picked at the end of October and transported in small bins. Classic red wine vinification at a controlled temperature of 25C takes place in stainless steel vats. The wine is aged in underground cellars for two years in French oak barrels and for a further year in the bottle. Suitable for aging up to 15 years.
